

ZACH SCOTT STREET & SCHIEFFER AVENUE

Zach Scott Street (Airport Boulevard to Berkman Drive) and Schieffer Avenue (Vineland Drive to Airport Boulevard)

As part of the 2016 Mobility Bond, the Austin Transportation Department recently completed a new two-way protected bikeway on Zach Scott Street. Austin Public Works' Safe Routes to School and Sidewalks programs also contributed to bicycle and pedestrian improvements through this project.



ABOUT THE IMPROVEMENTS

- New two-way protected bikeway on Zach Scott St. (from Airport Blvd. to Berkman Dr.) and Schieffer Ave. (from Airport Blvd. to Vineland Dr.), providing an improved bike route to Maplewood Elementary for students east of Airport Blvd.
- New shared use path connection to Patterson Neighborhood Park
- New bicycle signal at Airport Blvd. and Zach Scott St.
- New pedestrian crossing at Airport Blvd. and Zach Scott St.
- New protected intersections at Airport Blvd. and Berkman Dr., reducing crossing distances for people walking and people riding bikes
- New protected intersections at Berkman Dr. and Zach Scott St.
