EASTBOUND I-4 EXIT RAMP TO SOUTH STREET CLOSING ON NOVEMBER 15 AND 16

CONTINUOUS CLOSURE SCHEDULED TO BEGIN AS SOON AS 10 PM


The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is temporarily closing the eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) ramp to South Street (Exit 82B). The closure is scheduled to begin as soon as 10 p.m. on Friday, November 15, and conclude by 9 p.m. the following day. The closure is necessary for bridge work.

Traveling eastbound on I–4:

- Take the shared ramps to Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441/17-92) and Kaley Avenue (Exit 80)
- Stay left to continue to the Kaley Avenue exit ramp
- · At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Kaley Avenue
- Turn left onto Orange Avenue
- · Continue to South Street

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
