

WESTBOUND I-4 EXIT RAMP TO FAIRBANKS AVENUE CLOSING FOR A MONTH


CLOSURE ACCELERATES NEW WESTBOUND LANE CONSTRUCTION

The Florida Department of Transportation is closing the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) exit to Fairbanks Avenue (Exit 87) for a month starting as soon as 5 a.m. Monday, May 4, and continuing through June.

The closure provides space for crews to construct a new temporary westbound I-4 exit to Fairbanks Avenue and new westbound travel lanes. Traffic will shift onto the new bridge over Fairbanks Avenue when the closure is complete, accelerating construction by 1-2 months in this area.

Traveling to Fairbanks Avenue from westbound I–4:

- Continue west on I-4
- Use Exit 85 to Princeton Street
- Turn left onto Princeton Street
- Turn left onto Mills Avenue (U.S. 17-92)
- Continue to Fairbanks Avenue

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
