WB I-4 TRAFFIC PACING OPERATION SCHEDULED BETWEEN PAR STREET AND CONROY ROAD

A traffic pacing operation is scheduled to occur between midnight and 5 a.m. Friday, December 6 on westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from Par Street to Conroy Road. During the activity, westbound I-4 entrance ramps will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes an interchange, the westbound entrance ramp will be reopened to allow motorists to enter I-4 and join the slow roll. The traffic pacing operation and temporary ramp closures of westbound I-4 entrance ramps create a 30-minute window for crews to move equipment and install overhead signs.
