WESTBOUND I-4 TO STATE ROAD 434 EXIT SHIFTING TO TEMPORARY CONFIGURATION

MOTORISTS MUST USE WB I-4 REST AREA EXIT RAMP TO ACCESS S.R. 434

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is shifting the westbound I-4 exit ramp to State Road (S.R.) 434 (Exit 94) to a temporary configuration as soon as Wednesday morning, June 17.

The temporary exit is combined with the exit to the westbound rest area. To access S.R. 434 motorists must exit westbound I-4 approximately one mile sooner, just west of the E.E. Williamson overpass. Drivers will then travel the roadway to exit to S.R. 434.


This configuration will be in place through July 2020, while construction crews build permanent westbound general use lanes.

To facilitate the shift, FDOT will temporarily close the westbound I-4 exit to S.R. 434 and two right lanes on westbound I-4 from E.E. Williamson Road Bridge to the S.R. 434 exit ramp Tuesday night, June 16. Please see reverse side for more information.

Motorists are advised to maintain a safe speed when driving through the work zone and carefully follow roadway signs.

WESTBOUND I-4 TO STATE ROAD 434 **EXIT CLOSES OVERNIGHT**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is temporarily closing the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) exit ramp to State Road (S.R) 434 for one night.

The closure is scheduled to begin as early as 10 p.m. on Tuesday, June 16, and reopen in the new alignment the following morning.

The closure is necessary to facilitate a temporary configuration for motorists to access S.R. 434 from WB I-4 as construction crews build permanent westbound general use lanes. Please see reverse side for more information.


Motorists are advised to maintain a safe speed when driving through the work zone and carefully follow roadway signs.

Traveling on westbound I-4 to S.R. 434:

- Continue on westbound I-4 to S.R. 436 (Exit 92)
- Turn right onto S.R. 436
- · Continue to S.R. 434
