IN THE PAST 3 WEEKS, WE HAVE ADMINISTERED MORE THAN 152,000 VACCINES.


TODAY WE ARE ANNOUNCING THAT THE STATE IS ENTERING A NEW PHASE OF VACCINATIONS.





New virus variant possibly in Michigan




Potential post-holiday increase in cases

Vaccinating our seniors quickly will save lives




Michiganders over age 65... account for 80% of all COVID-19 deaths
