McLouth Steel Superfund Site Community Advisory Group Workshop February 13 2020 Meeting Summary

Proposed Convening Process

EPA held a workshop on Thursday, February 13, 2020 to as a next step to creating a Community Advisory Group for the McLouth Steel Superfund Site. The purpose of the meeting was to select membership for the McLouth Steel Superfund Site Community Advisory Group (CAG), review other process components, and brainstorm next steps for the CAG.

Prior to the meeting, the process facilitator proposed an approach for convening and selecting membership for the CAG. This included:

- identifying a set of governmental, institutional, and community stakeholders that had a stake and interest in the site
- developing a set of criteria for that all representatives could meet, and
- providing an "application" that all interested representatives could fill out to share their interests and qualifications.

At the meeting, each applicant had the opportunity to present to the full group about their interests and qualifications (applicants who were not present had their applications shared by another member or the facilitator), along with all additional applicants, who were able to speak to their interests. Meeting participants then had a chance to discuss all applicants in small groups. Reconvening in full group, meeting participants proposed accepting all applicants as CAG members, and convening as a CAG on March 12, 2020.
