



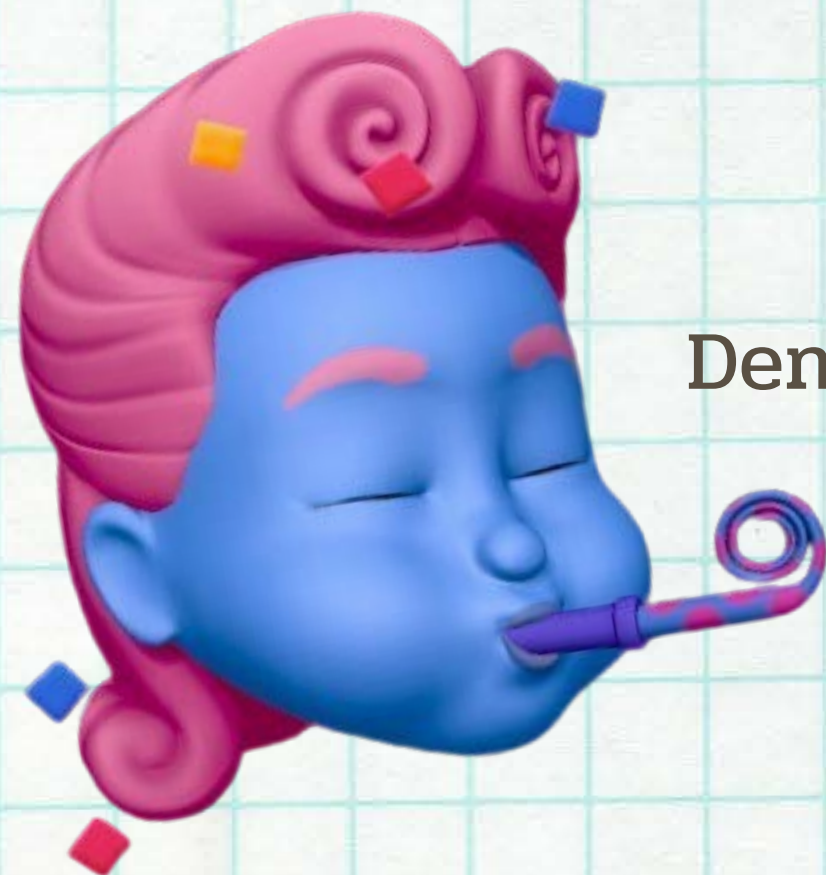

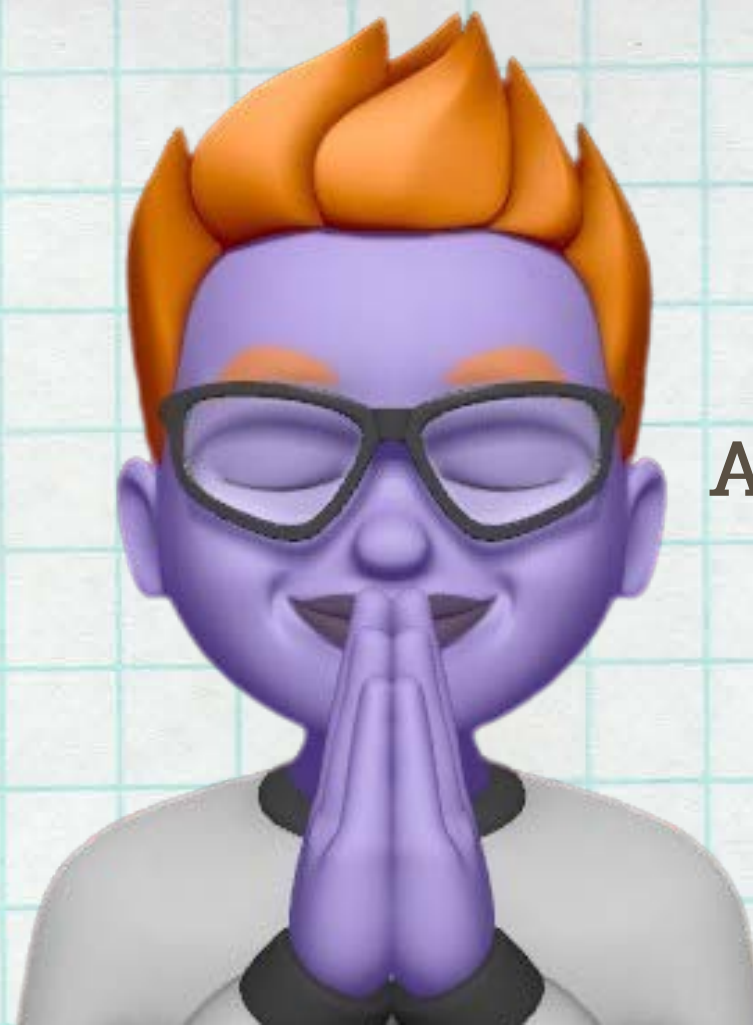

Rain Stick Craft

YOUR FINISHED CRAFT WILL LOOK LIKE THIS:

A rain stick is a long, hollow tube partially filled with small pebbles or beans that has small pins or thorns arranged helically on its inside surface. When the stick is upended, the pebbles fall to the other end of the tube, making a sound reminiscent of rain falling. The rain stick is believed to have been invented by the Mapuches, the Indigenous people of Chile, and was played in the belief it could bring about rainstorms. [wikipedia]

YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES:

- **Cardboard tube (paper towel size)**
- **Aluminum foil**
- **Paper**
- **Tape**
- **Scissors**
- **Rice (or substitute lentils, popcorn kernels, etc.)**
- **Broom handle or curtain rod**
- **Wooden spoon**
- **Funnel (helpful but optional)**
