

## Giving Notice for Electronic Meetings of Township Public Bodies under Public Act 228 of 2020 (Open Meetings Act)

#### **Notices for Electronic Meetings Must Include:**

Procedures by which the public is provided notice of the absence of the member and information about how to contact that member sufficiently in advance of a meeting of the public body to provide input on any business that will come before the public body. (MCL 15.263)

Subject to the requirements of MCL 15.263a, any scheduled meeting of a public body may be held as an electronic meeting under this section if a notice consistent with this section is posted at least 18 hours before the meeting begins.

Notice of a meeting of a public body **held electronically** must clearly explain all of the following:

- (a) Why the public body is meeting electronically.
- (b) How members of the public may participate in the meeting electronically. If a telephone number, internet address, or both are needed to participate, that information must be provided specifically.
- (c) How members of the public may contact members of the public body to provide input or ask questions on any business that will come before the public body at the meeting.
- (d) How persons with disabilities may participate in the meeting.

When, subject to MCL 15.263a, any member of the public body will be absent from an in-person meeting and participating electronically due to:

- Military duty,
- A medical condition, or
- A statewide or local state of emergency or state of disaster declared pursuant to law or charter by the
  governor or a local official or local governing body that would risk the personal health or safety of
  members of the public or the public body if the meeting were held in person

then the public body is required to adopt procedures by which the public is provided **notice of the absence** of the member and information about how to contact that member sufficiently in advance of a meeting of the public body to provide input on any business that will come before the public body. (MCL 15.263)

#### **Notices for Electronic Meetings Must be Posted:**

Any **notice** of a meeting of a township public body is required by the OMA to be **posted** ("put up") on the township's notice board (window, wall, board).

(Note that <u>other</u> laws may require a published, posted or mailed notice of a public hearing or other action to be included at a meeting. "Published" means published in a newspaper. The OMA does not require regular or special meeting notices to be published.)

#### Website:

<u>IF</u> a public body directly or indirectly maintains an official website ("internet presence") that includes monthly or more frequent updates of public meeting agendas or minutes, the public body must post advance notice of a meeting held electronically on a portion of the public body's website that is fully accessible to the public, in addition to any other notices that may be required under the OMA. (MCL 15.263a)

The public notice on the website must be included on either the homepage or on a separate webpage dedicated to public notices for special ("nonregularly scheduled") or electronic public meetings that is accessible through a prominent and conspicuous link on the website's homepage that clearly describes its purpose for public notification of special ("nonregularly scheduled") or electronic public meetings. (MCL 15.263a)

#### **Special Meeting Notices (in-person or electronic):**

The OMA also requires that **special meeting** notices (meetings that are not on the regular meeting schedule) be posted at least 18 hours before the meeting in a prominent and conspicuous place at both the public body's principal office.

#### Website:

<u>IF</u> the public body directly or indirectly maintains an official website ("internet presence") that includes monthly or more frequent updates of public meeting agendas or minutes, then special meeting notices must also be posted on a portion of the website that is fully accessible to the public.

The public notice on the website must be included on either the homepage or on a separate webpage dedicated to public notices for special ("nonregularly scheduled") public meetings and accessible via a prominent and conspicuous link on the website's homepage that clearly describes its purpose for public notification of those special ("nonregularly scheduled") public meetings. (MCL 15.265)

#### Agendas:

<u>IF</u> an agenda exists for an **electronic** meeting held and <u>IF</u> the public body directly or indirectly maintains an official website ("internet presence") that includes monthly or more frequent updates of public meeting agendas or minutes, the public body must make the **agenda** available to the public at least 2 hours before the electronic meeting begins on a portion of the website that is fully accessible to the public. This does not prevent the public body from amending the agenda at the meeting. (MCL 15.263a)

Sample Notes: This notice must be posted at a prominent and conspicuous place at the township office within 10 days after the first meeting of the board for its fiscal or calendar year, so that it is visible to the public for the entire time it is posted. If there is a change in the schedule of regular meetings of a public body, the amended schedule must be posted within 3 days after the meeting at which the change is made, and it must be posted at least 18 hours prior to the time of the next meeting on the schedule. If the township maintains a website that is updated at least monthly with meeting agendas or minutes, this notice must also be posted on that website at least 18 hours prior to the time of the meeting. (MCL 15.265)
