- PURPOSE: Hold a public hearing and consider action

The County Council will hold a public hearing and consider action on a supplemental appropriation to the FY19 Operating Budget, Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS), \$300,743 for the Learning in Extended Academic Programs (LEAP) Grant. The source of funds is the Maryland State Department of Education.

The County Executive recommends approval of this appropriation (©1), and a draft appropriation resolution is attached at ©2-3. The Board of Education requested this appropriation on January 8, 2019 (transmittal attached on ©4-6). The Council introduced this supplemental appropriation on March 12. As a grant award, there is no effect on the County's current or future maintenance of effort requirements.

The purpose of a LEAP grant is to provide extended academic programming that has a positive measurable impact on or enriches the academic performance and overall well-being of students who are at risk of falling behind academic requirements. Funds will be used to lengthen the Extended Learning Opportunities Summer Adventures in Learning program by an additional five days.

## SUBJECT: Supplemental Appropriation #19-434 to the FY19 Operating Budget Montgomery County Public Schools Learning in Extended Academic Programs Grant, \$300,743

## Background

- 1. Section 307 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that any supplemental appropriation shall be recommended by the County Executive who shall specify the source of funds to finance it. The Council shall hold a public hearing on each proposed supplemental appropriation after at least one week's notice. A supplemental appropriation that would comply with, avail the County of, or put into effect a grant or a Federal, State or County law or regulation, or one that is approved after January 1 of any fiscal year, requires an affirmative vote of five Councilmembers. A supplemental appropriation for any other purpose that is approved before January 1 of any fiscal year requires an affirmative vote of six Councilmembers. The Council may, in a single action, approve more than one supplemental appropriation. The Executive may disapprove or reduce a supplemental appropriation, and the Council may reapprove the appropriation, as if it were an item in the annual budget.
- 2. The County Executive has requested the following FY19 Operating Budget appropriation increases for Montgomery County Public Schools

- 3. This increase is needed to provide spending authority for the use of grant funds received from the Maryland State Department of Education. As a grant award, there is no effect on the County's current or future maintenance of effort requirements.
- 4. The County Executive recommends a supplemental appropriation to the FY19 Operating Budget in the amount of \$300,743 for the Learning in Extended Academic Programs Grant and specifies that the source of funds will be grant funds from the Maryland State Department of Education.
- 5. Notice of public hearing was given, and a public hearing was held.

Subject: Recommended Fiscal Year 2019 Supplemental Appropriation for Learning in Extended Academic Programs Grant

### **Recommendation in Brief**

Authorization is requested to receive and expend, subject to County Council approval, a Fiscal Year 2019 supplemental appropriation of \$300,743 for Learning in Extended Academic Programs (LEAP) Grant. The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) has approved Montgomery County Public Schools' (MCPS) grant application. Notice of Grant Award will be received upon MSDE's approval of the program budget, which was signed by the MCPS chief financial officer on September 14, 2018, and submitted to MSDE. Recipient assurance was signed by the superintendent of schools on November 28, 2018. Therefore, similar to the Provision for Future Supported Projects, authorization is being requested by the Board and subsequently from the County Council subject to the receipt of the grant award.

#### Background

The purpose of a LEAP grant is to provide extended academic programming that has a positive measurable impact on or enriches the academic performance and overall well-being of students who are at risk of falling behind academic requirements. Public schools with at least 80 percent of students who qualify for free and reduced-priced meals services are eligible for assistance from a LEAP grant. Funds will be used to lengthen the Extended Learning Opportunities Summer Adventures in Learning (ELO SAIL) program by an additional five days.

#### Support of Board of Education Mission

The LEAP grant is fully supported by the mission of Board of Education: every student will have the academic, creative problem solving and social emotional skills to be successful in college and career. It sets the course to offer special assistance to students from low income families

### Members of the Board of Education

who are at risk of falling behind academic requirements. These students will have more equitable access to educational resources that otherwise may be unavailable to them.

### Use of Funds

Funds will be used to provide for:

- Professional Part-time Salaries;
- Supporting Services Part-time Salaries;
- Associated Employee Benefits;
- Contractual Services;
- Instructional Materials; and
- Student Transportation.

### **Recommended Resolution**

WHEREAS, Montgomery County Public Schools has received notification from the Maryland State Department of Education that it will receive \$300,743 for the Learning in Extended Academic Programs grant; now therefore be it

<u>Resolved</u>, That the superintendent of schools be authorized to receive and expend, subject to the notice of grant award from the Maryland State Department of Education and County Council approval, a Fiscal Year supplemental appropriation of \$300,743 for the Learning in Extended Academic Programs grant in the following categories:
