PURPOSE:

Hold a public hearing and consider action

The County Council will hold a public hearing and consider action on a supplemental appropriation to the FY19 Operating Budget, Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS), \$2,068,305 for the Title IV, Part A: Student Support Enrichment Grant. The source of funds is the Maryland State Department of Education.

The County Executive recommends approval of this appropriation (©1), and a draft appropriation resolution is attached at ©2-3. The Board of Education requested this appropriation on January 8, 2019 (transmittal attached on ©4-6). The Council introduced this supplemental appropriation on March 12. As a grant award, there is no effect on the County's current or future maintenance of effort requirements.

The purpose of the Title IV, Part A grant is to provide all students with access to a well-rounded education, improve school conditions for student learning, and improve the use of technology in order to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy of all students.

The funds will be used for instruction in coding and robotics; expansion of the digital citizenship program; personalized learning for at-risk students; expansion of restorative justice practices; expansion of world language education in elementary schools; summer enrichment experiences to deepen collage and career readiness; mental health supports to students; covering costs for Career and Technology Education assessments; and students' project-based learning experiences with the fine arts.

I am recommending a supplemental appropriation to the FY19 Operating Budget of Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) in the amount of \$2,068,305 for the Title IV, Part A: Student Support Enrichment Grant. This appropriation will provide instruction in coding and robotics beginning at elementary schools; expansion of the digital citizenship program; personalized learning for at-risk students; expansion of restorative justice practices; and expansion of world language education in elementary schools. It will also provide at the secondary level: summer enrichment experiences to deepen college and career readiness; mental health supports; the costs for Career and Technology Education assessments; and students' project-based learning experiences with the fine arts.

This supplemental appropriation is needed to provide spending authority for grant funds received from the Maryland State Department of Education. As a grant award, there is no effect on the County's current or future maintenance of effort requirements.

I recommend that the County Council approve this supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$2,068,305 and specify the source of funds as Maryland State Department of Education Title IV, Part A: Student Support Enrichment Grant.

Title IV, Part A: Student Support Enrichment Grant, \$2,068,305

Background

- 1. Section 307 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that any supplemental appropriation shall be recommended by the County Executive who shall specify the source of funds to finance it. The Council shall hold a public hearing on each proposed supplemental appropriation after at least one week's notice. A supplemental appropriation that would comply with, avail the County of, or put into effect a grant or a Federal, State or County law or regulation, or one that is approved after January 1 of any fiscal year, requires an affirmative vote of five Councilmembers. A supplemental appropriation for any other purpose that is approved before January 1 of any fiscal year requires an affirmative vote of six Councilmembers. The Council may, in a single action, approve more than one supplemental appropriation. The Executive may disapprove or reduce a supplemental appropriation, and the Council may reapprove the appropriation, as if it were an item in the annual budget.
- 2. The County Executive has requested the following FY19 Operating Budget appropriation increases for Montgomery County Public Schools

- 3. This increase is needed to provide spending authority for the use of grant funds received from the Maryland State Department of Education. As a grant award, there is no effect on the County's current or future maintenance of effort requirements.

Recommendation in Brief

Authorization is requested to receive and expend, subject to County Council approval, a Fiscal Year 2019 supplemental appropriation of \$2,068,305 for Title IV, Part A: Student Support and Academic Enrichment Grant. The Maryland State Department of Education has approved Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) grant application. Notice of Grant Award will be received when final master plans for all local education agencies in Maryland are approved. Therefore, similar to the Provision for Future Supported Projects, authorization is being requested by the Board and subsequently from the County Council subject to the receipt of the grant award.

Background

The purpose of the Title IV, Part A grant is to provide all students with access to a well-rounded education, improve school conditions for student learning, and improve the use of technology in order to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy of all students.

The funds will be used for instruction in coding and robotics beginning at elementary schools; expansion of the digital citizenship program; personalized learning for at-risk students; expansion of restorative justice practices; and expansion of world language education in elementary schools. At the secondary level, funds will be used for summer enrichment experiences to deepen college and career readiness, mental health supports to students, covering costs for Career and Technology Education assessments, and students' project-based learning experiences with the fine arts.

Support of Board of Education Mission

The Title IV, Part A Student Support and Academic Enrichment Grant is fully supported by the mission of the Board of Education: every student will have the academic, creative problem solving and social emotional skills to be successful in college and career. It provides well-rounded education opportunities to all students in MCPS in both elementary and secondary levels, personalized learning opportunities for at-risk students, mental health support to students in need, fine arts education, and assistance to improve career readiness.

Use of Funds

Funds will be used to provide for:

- Professional Part-time Salaries;
- Associated Employee Benefits;
- Supporting Services Part-time Salaries;
- Contractual Services;
- Instructional Materials; and
- Student Transportation.
