COUNCIL DECISION POINTS & COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

• Council sitting as Board of Health to receive updates.

DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

At this session, the Council will receive updates regarding public health and emergency management, including hospital surge planning and increased capacity for testing. The Council will also be provided with an update and discuss the work being done to reach Montgomery County's diverse communities with the critical information they need to respond to the COVID-19 health crisis. This includes translation of press releases, videos, and other information into multiple languages, the use of multiple communications platforms in multiple languages (such as Spanish language radio and television and the addition of the WhatsApp platform), and communications with special populations, such as the disability community. Mr. Hartman is the County Executive's lead in this effort and is working in coordination with and support from the County Council's multi-cultural communications team.

COVID-19 Background (from Maryland.gov)

COVID-19 is a disease caused by a respiratory virus first identified in Wuhan, Hubei Province, China in December 2019. COVID-19 is a new virus that hasn't caused illness in humans before. Worldwide, COVID-19 has resulted in thousands of infections, causing illness and in some cases death. Cases have spread to countries throughout the world, with more cases reported daily.

COVID-19 is thought to be able to spread like the cold or flu through:

Coughing and sneezing, which creates respiratory droplets Close personal contact, such as touching or shaking hands Touching an object or surface with the virus on it

Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

Fever

Coughing

Shortness of breath

In more severe cases, pneumonia (infection in the lungs)

The vast majority of people recover from this infection. Most people will have mild or moderate symptoms. Older people and those with pre-existing medical conditions have a greater risk for more serious illness.
