DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

Each year the Council may set a property tax credit to offset a portion of the income tax revenue resulting from a County income tax rate that is greater than 2.6%. This credit is automatically provided to each property that is an owner-occupied dwelling of a homeowner.

SUMMARY OF KEY DISCUSSION POINTS

- The Executive recommended a property tax credit of \$800 per eligible property in the recommended FY21 Operating Budget. The FY20 credit was \$692.
- The Council will consider the setting of property tax rates generally, including this property tax credit and the Executive's recommendation, as it considers the FY21 Operating Budget.
