- Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled 1 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration 2 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery 3 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes 5 from State and local taxation and making an appropriation," in State lottery, further providing for powers and duties of 7 8 secretary. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State Lottery Law, is 12

- (a) Powers and duties enumerated. -- In addition to the powers 15
- 16 and duties provided by law and the act of April 9, 1929
- 17 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, the
- 18 secretary shall have the power and it shall be his duty to
- operate and administer the lottery, and to promulgate rules and 19
- regulations governing the establishment and operation thereof, 20

3 (11) The apportionment of the total revenues accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares and from all other 4 5 sources among:

7 (iv) for property tax relief and free or reduced 8 fare transit service for the elderly as provided in 9 section 311. For fiscal years beginning before July 1, 10 2014, no less than 27% of the total revenues accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares shall be 11 12 dedicated to this subparagraph. For fiscal years 13 beginning after June 30, 2014, and ending June 30, 2019, 14 no less than 25% of the total revenues accruing from the 15 sale of lottery tickets or shares shall be dedicated to 16 this subparagraph. For fiscal years beginning after June 30, 2019, and ending June 30, 2022 2024, no less than 23% <--17 18 20% of the total revenues accruing from the sale of <--19 lottery tickets or shares shall be dedicated to this 20 subparagraph. For fiscal years beginning after June 30, 2022 2024, no less than 25% of the total revenues 21 <--22 accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares shall 23 be dedicated to this subparagraph. \* \* \*

25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
